## **COVID-19 ACTION PLANS – SUMMARY**

SCENARIO		ACTION	COMMUNICATION
1	A student or staff member exhibits COVID-19 <b>symptoms</b> or has a temperature of 100.4 or above	<ul> <li>Report information to Site Administrator and send staff / student home.</li> <li>Refer to YKHC for testing.</li> <li>If positive, see Scenario #3.</li> <li>If negative, see Scenario #4.</li> <li>School / Classroom remains OPEN.</li> </ul>	See Scenario #3 or Scenario #4
2	A family member or someone in close contact with a student or staff member tests <b>positive</b> for COVID-19. (Outside of the household – Not Ongoing Exposure)	<ul> <li>Close contact: anyone within 0-3 feet for more than 15 minutes or unmasked individuals within 6 feet. <u>The CDC does not include classmates within 3-6 feet of an infected student if the exposed student correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time.</u></li> <li>VACCINATED RECENTLY (within 5 months for Pfizer or Moderna, or 2 months with J&amp;J) OR BOOSTED:         <ul> <li>No need to quarantine at home after exposure</li> <li>Wear a mask around others for 10 days (required in schools)</li> <li>Test after FIVE days, or if you develop symptoms prior</li> </ul> </li> <li>UNVACCINATED OR NOT VACCINATED RECENTLY         <ul> <li>Quarantine at home and test on day 5; if test is negative, return to school on day 6</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Cohort notification of close contact situation
3	A student or staff member tests <b>positive</b> for COVID-19.	<ul> <li>Wear a mask around others for 10 days</li> <li>Household members of close contacts are exempt from the quarantine requirement in order to attend school. If anyone becomes symptomatic, they should immediately test and isolate.</li> <li>Report to YKHC and refer to YKHC for testing.</li> <li>Disinfection and cleaning of classroom.</li> <li>School / Classroom remains OPEN.</li> <li>Report information to Site Administrator and send staff / student home, following protocols below.</li> <li>Report to YKHC.</li> </ul>	Cohort notification of confirmed Covid- 19 in cohort situation
		<ul> <li>Disinfection and Cleaning of Classroom.</li> <li>Classroom may remain OPEN or temporarily CLOSE after consultation with YKHC and local tribal governance where applicable.</li> <li>School remains OPEN.</li> </ul> FOR STAFF: <ul> <li>Isolate for 5 days</li> <li>On fifth day, if no symptoms or symptoms are resolving and fever has resolved for at least 24 hours, you may test out of isolation with a negative COVID antigen test and return to work on day 6, adhering to the following guidance:</li> <li>A well-fitting mask should be worn any time you are around others (required in school)</li> <li>Avoid eating around others and any situation that involves taking your mask off around others</li> </ul>	



		<ul> <li>Avoid all activities that are high risk for COVID 19 transmission</li> <li>Avoid all high-risk individuals (e.g., the very young or elderly, and people who are immunocompromised or unvaccinated)</li> <li>Date of return to "essential activities" will be provided on official YKHC letterhead and provided to school/supervisor</li> <li>On day 5, if test is positive or if you continue to be symptomatic, continue to isolate for an additional 5 days (10 days total)</li> <li>FOR STUDENTS:         <ul> <li>Isolate for ten days</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
		Date of return to "all normal activities" will be provided on official YKHC letterhead and provided to school/supervisor	
4	A student or staff member tests <b>negative</b> for COVID-19 after symptoms.	<ul> <li>The student or staff may return to school 24 hours after symptoms resolve.</li> <li>School / Classroom remains OPEN.</li> <li>If there is ongoing exposure in immediate household see Scenario 5</li> </ul>	
5	A member of student/staff immediate household tests	For fully vaccinated household members with <u>ongoing exposure</u> to an individual with COVID-19, YKHC recommends the individual quarantine for the same length of time the index patient is in isolation. COVID-19 testing should occur on Day 1, followed by repeat testing	Cohort notification of close contact situation

on Day 3-5 and the end of quarantine. Symptom monitoring should

also be performed for a full 14 days, following the last day of possible
